Notice is hereby given that your FY2018 County and City Taxes, which cover the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, are payable in two (2) equal installments on September 08, 2017 and March 09, 2018. Interest will be charged on the first installment at an annual rate of 7% starting on September 09, 2017. Interest will be charged on the second installment at an annual rate of 7% starting March 10, 2018.

General Information:

Questions concerning the values of your properties or exemptions should be directed to assessors@portlandmaine.gov, the Assessor's Office located in Room 115 of City Hall or by phone at (207) 874-8486. If you have owned your home for 12 months or more you may qualify for a Homestead Exemption. If you are a veteran you may qualify for a Veterans Exemption. - For all payments please make your check payable to <u>City of Portland.</u>
- You may make payments online at http://portlandmaine.gov/1567/Pay-Your-Property-Taxes-On-Line. Payments may be made via eCheck for a \$1.50 service charge or via credit card for a 2.65% convenience charge.
- For payments in person for your tax bill please go to Room 102, Treasury Office, located at City Hall. Treasury Hours are Monday through Friday 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.
- For bill amounts and tax inquiries, please email treasury@portlandmaine.gov or call (207) 874-8490

Please be aware that if you have any past due amounts on your tax bill that your payment will be applied to the oldest outstanding amount due. This bill is for the current fiscal year only. Past due amounts are not included. After eight months and no later than one year from the date of commitment, a lien will be placed on all real estate for taxes left unpaid.

<u>Automated Tax Payments for FY2018 Tax Bill:</u> The City of Portland has a convenient way to pay your Taxes in monthly installment by EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer). You can authorize the City to charge your bank account monthly and apply the funds to your annual bill. If ownership of your property has changed, please check the box on the front side and fill in Owner/Address Change section located in the bottom left margin of your tax bill.
